Sutton Cellars began in 1996 with the production of a mere 350 cases of four different wines. Each wine has always been driven by single-vineyard or site-specific expressions of the varietals; fermented with wild yeast, and using a minimum of new oak with no fining or filtration. Almost all wines are bottled by gravity and by hand. The grapes are sourced mostly from the Russian River and Bennett Valleys and the Sonoma Coast with a few grapes coming from Mendocino County.

By 2015 he should be either back in SOMA or in the Outer Richmond or the Presidio, depending on which mathematical model one uses. In 2009 Mel was knighted by the French government and is now a Chevalier of the Order of the Merite Agricole, along with Louis Pasteur and Martine Saulnier.
